Dear Sir/Madam, I wish to raise one specific point regarding the Consultation Paper and draft regulations.

In South Australia, it is possible to set up an association without members, and this structure is (for example) used where the relevant association is effectively going to be a mere 'subsidiary' of another association.

It would therefore be good if such structures were expressly recognised in the discussion of standards 1 and 2 in the Consultation Paper (which discussion currently assumes that an association will always have members), and perhaps in the drafting of those standards (if this is seen as necessary).
