BANKING AMENDMENT (CREDIT CARD) REGULATION 2014

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the draft *Banking Amendment (Credit Card) Regulation 2014* (Regulation).

As you would be aware, Visa Inc. is the world's largest electronic payments network. We operate one of the world's most advanced processing networks – VisaNet – that is capable of handling more than 24,000 transaction messages a second, with fraud protection for consumers and assured payment for merchants.
