Please ensure that factory farms aren't operating under the 'free range' label, and that egg labels clearly explain the living standards of the hens who laid them.

- **Implement** a system that clearly reflects the stocking density of laying hens on the egg carton label.
- **Enforce** a maximum 'free-range' stocking density of 1,500-2,500 hens per hectare.
- Create a new label (separate to 'free range') to describe the new multi-tiered 'intensive' barn systems, where hens have some access to the outdoors (at a density of up to 10,000 hens per hectare).
- **Ensure** eggs used in food manufacturing and catering are clearly labelled in the ingredients list as being cage, barn, or free-range laid eggs.
