As a registered charity in NSW, it is listed on the federal Register of Cultural Organisations eligible to receive tax-deductible donations.

First held in 1933 and originally known as the City of Sydney Eisteddfod, it is widely regarded as the largest and most successful competitive performing arts festival in the world. Subject to individual event guidelines, it offers classical and contemporary events for budding artists of all ages and types.
