Thank you for the opportunity to make a submission on the proposal to remake the *Statistics Determination 1983* (the Determination).

The Department of Agriculture and Water Resources (the department) works closely with the Australian Bureau of Statistics (ABS) on a number of data-centric initiatives. This sees both agencies share and use data to undertake research and analysis and provide advice to inform decision makers on issues affecting Australia's agriculture, fisheries, forestry and water industries.

It is noted that the proposed remake of the Determination will bring it in line with contemporary drafting practices and provide for a more flexible scheme under which the ABS can release business information. We welcome and strongly support greater sharing of the data that the government holds in an appropriate manner. We note that the remake maintains safeguards for matters such as privacy.
