I refer to your Exposure Draft 013 entitled “Payslip Reporting of Superannuation Contributions”, dated 14 February 2012.

I would like to note that in general, software developers require at least 6 months to implement and test software changes. In particular, if the change is not related to the tax year, the changes should not occur during the time when payroll staff are the busiest ie in July. Preferably changes such as superannuation information on payslips should be effective on the 1st January of the year.
